Repair Affair helps people who...

- ◆ Own their home
- ◆ Are at least 60 years old or certified as disabled
- ◆ Qualify as low income—50% of area median or less

Repair Affair is an Event...

- ◆ Volunteers making prioritized repairs
- ◆ Not redecorating or remodeling
- ◆ Not an emergency repair program
- ◆ Not a year round program
- ◆ Ramps, rails, grab bars, doors, windows, locks, etc.

Repair Affair works!

- ◆ Homes are made safer, stronger, more weather resistant and more secure
- ◆ Precious housing stock is maintained
- ◆ Neighborhoods remain/regain stability
- ◆ Thanks to the power of volunteerism so much is done for so little cost
- ◆ Leverage: Volunteer efforts are sometimes combined with professionally contracted repairs. The result is major change and improvement

Repair Affair 2004 Results

212 Homeowners applied
167 in Louisville from 19 of the
26 Metro Districts
45 in Southern Indiana

19 of 26 Louisville Metro districts had at least one home selected and repaired

1,436 Volunteers
1,141 in Louisville
295 in Southern Indiana

151 Homes, sheltering **221 residents**, received repairs
110 in Louisville
41 in Southern Indiana

Completed repairs include:

Wheel chair ramps
Handrails
Grab bars
Door/window repair
Floor repair
Minor electric/plumbing
Minor roof repair
Interior/exterior paint
